# SouthPeak Alternative Alpha Fund

#### **Description**

The Fund invests into the SouthPeak real diversification fund (8-16% vol) (SouthPeak). The Fund aims to provide consistent returns above the RBA daily cash rate target with low correlation to bonds and shares (measured daily) and strong resilience to large equity falls.

The Fund is intended for a consumer who is seeking capital growth and regular income through diversification away from traditional asset classes, such as shares and bonds, with the goal of increasing stability of their overall returns across a range of market conditions.

It is intended to offer synergies, within the context of a broader diversified investment portfolio, by providing resistance to broader market downturns through owning alternative investments that have low correlation to traditional markets.

#### **Investment Objective**

Provide a total return, after costs and before tax, above the Fund's performance benchmark on a rolling 5-year basis.
